BOND PROGRAM KICK OFF-NEXT SUNDAY!

I will never forget my first experience as a preacher with a church conducting a bond program. It was in 1977. The Salem congregation, in Florence, AL was planning to build a new 800 seat auditorium. Our elders decided that this was the best way to finance the project. A presentation was made before the entire church informing them of all the details and investment opportunities. Over half the bonds were reserved by the members on the first day! We sold the rest ourselves and saved the church a lot of money in fees that are charged by the financial institution for selling them to outside investors. Beth and I bought two bonds for our children's future college expenses and 15 years later, we were blessed with triple our investment! Beth's parents had already purchased some church bonds for our boy's college education when the congregation where they worshipped was building a new building and were using a bond program.

With the present economic environment, most people are only receiving a small amount of interest on bank saving accounts, annuities, and CD's, making church bonds with higher interest a more attractive investment and an extremely secure one. Lake Harbour Drive is a spiritually healthy, united and growing congregation with land and building assets debt free. Banks are lending at low rates right now, but they will only lock loans in for short periods since they are anticipating that interest rates will jump after the economy improves. With "church bonds" interest rates can be locked in long term and they can be paid off early with no penalty. **Next Sunday, immediately following our A.M. worship, Ben Kern, a representative with Rives, Leavell & Company will be providing us with all the information about our bond program.** We have been given assurance that these bonds will sell out fast as they have investors outside the church who are waiting in the wings to snap them up. Whether you think you might be interested in buying bonds or not, it will be important that all of us are fully informed as possible because this is a congregational commitment that involves all of us.

I want to encourage you to look closer at the information that has already been provided to you, attend the meeting next Sunday, and consider helping the church as well as yourself by investing as much as you can in our "church bond program," and sharing the information with others you know might be interested. Remember, this is not taking the place of our previous Capital Campaign commitments. We need each member who made pledges in 2009 to continue to fulfill them according to your ability just as you have been doing faithfully. Let's also continue to pray for God to bless these plans!

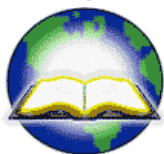
