That day when evening came, he said to his disciples, "Let us go over to the other side." Leaving the crowd behind, they took him along, just as he was, in the boat. There were also other boats with him. A furious squall came up, and the waves broke over the boat, so that it was nearly swamped. Jesus was in the stern, sleeping on a cushion. The disciples woke him and said to him, "Teacher, don't you care if we drown?" He got up, rebuked the wind and said to the waves, "Quiet! Be still!" Then the wind died down and it was completely calm. He said to his disciples, "Why are you so afraid? Do you still have no faith?" They were terrified and asked each other, "Who is this? Even the wind and the waves obey him!" Mark 4.35-41, NIV.

In this passage we find the epitome of current thought concerning God during hard times. Notice the question asked by the disciples when faced with the devastating storm: "Teacher, don't you care if we drown?" I believe this is an accurate portrayal of how we often respond to hardship. Sadly, it is a lack of faith that causes this response. Today, we have the opportunity to change our response to a faith-filled one – because, let's face it, many hardships loom in our path. Here are a couple of tips on how to revive your response to hard times.

1) Turning to God is good; blaming him is bad. The twelve resorted to blaming God with their statement "don't you care?" We should have no doubt whatsoever that God cares for us – after all, he sacrificed his son so that we could have eternal life.

2) Imitate Jesus. Do you ever wonder how this story would have turned out if the twelve went to the stern of the boat and slept? You see, by imitating Jesus, we are invited to endure hardship with ease and grace.

It takes a great faith to go and 'rest' with God during hard times, but isn't that a marvelous invitation? I pray that when your next struggle comes, you turn to God and take Him up on his offer of 'rest.'
