### **REMEMBERING OUR MILITARY HEROES**

Memorial Day is observed annually on the last Monday in May to honor of our nation's military heroes killed in wartime. There are many stories as to its actual beginnings. Over two dozen cities and towns lay claim to being the birthplace of Memorial Day. It was first officially proclaimed on May 5, 1868, by General John Logan, national commander of the Grand Army of the Republic, and was first observed on May 30, 1868, when flowers were placed on the graves of Union and Confederate soldiers at Arlington National Cemetery. It is now celebrated on the last Monday in May. Canadian poet John McCrae was a surgeon in World War I, and on December 8, 1915, he published a poem to commemorate the deaths of thousands of young men who died in Flanders during the grueling battles there. Flanders covered southern Belgium and northwest France. Incidentally, my birthplace of Longwy, France is located in this area. On a vacation to my homeland years ago, Beth and I visited the WWI memorial cemetery in Verdon, which contains the graves of thousands of brave American soldiers who sacrificed their lives to help free France from the Germans. Legend has it that John McCrae was inspired by seeing the blood-red poppies blooming in the fields of France where many friends had died to write the following poem that was used as a recruiting tool during World War I:

*In Flanders fields the poppies blow between the crosses, row on row  
That mark our place; and in the sky the larks, still bravely singing, fly  
Scarce heard amid the guns below.  
We are the Dead. Short days ago we lived, felt dawn, saw sunset glow,  
Loved and were loved, and now we lie in Flanders fields.  
Take up our quarrel with the foe: to you from failing hands we throw  
The torch; be yours to hold it high.  
If ye break faith with us who die  
We shall not sleep, though poppies grow in  
Flanders fields.*



In 1918, inspired by that poem, an American teacher named Moina Michael, wrote her own poem entitled "We Shall Keep The Faith."

*We cherish too, the Poppy red that grows on fields where valor led.  
It seems to signal to the skies that blood of heroes never dies.*

Having served in the U.S. Marines during the Vietnam Conflict, I often reflect on those comrades in arms that I served with that did not return alive. I'm grateful that I escaped having to go to that very unpopular war, and I regret that most of those who came home alive were not treated with the respect they deserved. I hope you will join me this weekend in taking time to remember and honor all our fallen heroes of all wars for their ultimate sacrifice and especially our spiritual hero and "Commander in Chief" of the Lord's Army as we gather to "proclaim his death." Let each of us as "soldiers of Christ" arise to worship our Savior who lives and reigns at the right hand of God!
