### ***CATCH UP CONTRIBUTION SUNDAY, AUGUST 28***

The 2010 weekly budget for underwriting all our ministry commitments was set at the beginning of the year at **\$6,000**. In light of our building program, bond payment and increase in missions, this budget did not include a “cushion” for miscellaneous expenses, but every dollar was specified for our various programs of work. The congregation has graciously accepted the challenge, resulting in an average for the year of about **\$5,900** per week. In addition, the church has given over and above our regular weekly giving to our **“Setting Up a Pillar of Service”** campaign since it began May, 2009 in the amount of **\$202,578!** This is outstanding for a church our size!

***However, as of last Sunday, we have fallen short of our weekly budget by \$2,600.*** In order to get our actual weekly giving in balance with our budget, we are encouraging every member to participate in a one-time **“Catch-up”** contribution on ***Sunday, August 28***. Assuming we make the budget for the next seven Sundays, the total amount needed will be **\$7,600**. We want to inform you of this need well in advance to give everyone plenty of time to prepare. We urge everyone to willingly plan to cooperate and prayerfully consider the following:

- (1) If you have missed any week this year in giving what you pledged at the first of the year, plan to “make up” and get “caught up” all you can. Maybe during the summer vacation months you missed a few Sundays. Biblical giving is a personal proof of our faith offered cheerfully as we have purposed from the heart and never reluctantly or out of necessity, but as we have been prospered and according to our ability and opportunity.
- (2) If you have been blessed with additional income in the form of bonuses, dividends on investments, raises in salary, or financial gifts, contribute a portion to help this need.
- (3) If each of our 100 families added to their regular weekly offering \$26 we would reach the goal of \$7,600. A few of us may need to give less, but many of us may be able to give more. In either case, let's give all we can to erase this deficit.

***Let's each give with equal sacrifice; not with equal gifts, but let's all give prayerfully, willingly, joyously and thankfully with a desire to please God who has been extremely gracious and generous to us individually and to his church at LHD...***

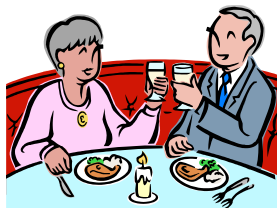


## Senior Saints
