### ALL-CHURCH POTLUCK FELLOWSHIP—SUNDAY, AUGUST 30

As I mentioned two weeks ago, Freddie and Sabrina Williams have been re-organizing our church family ministry system. The final plans have been approved by the elders and we are ready to begin. All the church families will be grouped into three geographical Action Teams: (1) Rankin County, (2) Hinds County & Ridgeland, (3) Madison County, including Madison City and Canton. We will kick off this revised program on Sunday, August 30, with an all-church family pot-luck lunch after morning worship. The fellowship room will be set up so that we can sit with the families on our Action Team to give us the opportunity to identify who is in our group. Freddie, deacon over this ministry, will give us a short exhortation about our purpose and go over how we will work our new Action Teams. I want to encourage every family to make plans to be a part of this fellowship. Let's make this the largest gathering at LHD year to date and finally break that 209 goal!!!! We came close to reaching it last Sunday!

### NEW ADULT FALL BIBLE CLASSES

As we swing out of summer and into fall, I'm excited about our adult Bible class changes that are forthcoming. On Sunday morning, Dustin Abbott will continue teaching the Gospel of John to the 20's & 30's couples and singles in the fellowship room. On the first Sunday in September, L. C. Reese will begin a Scripture study in the auditorium with the older adults called "God's Supremes" based on a 13 part study of Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians & Philemon. On Wednesday nights beginning August 26, Ollie Hamblin will teach an auditorium class on a Bible subject of his choice that he has been studying. Which will be announced later. Our Wednesday night ladies' class starts back on September 2, with Virginia Hamblin as the lead teacher. They will be using the book "**Choosing Life's Best**" as a study guide. If you plan to participate and need a book, check with Virginia. Eddie Perkins has already started a New Christian's class studying fundamentals of the faith, but it's not too late to get in on it if you feel you need to re-visit the basics of Christianity. For the fall quarter on Sunday morning and Wednesday nights I will be available in my office to meet with prospective members with a LHD 101-orientation class for anyone who has special needs for prayer and counseling, has particular Bible questions they would like answered, or wish to study the Bible one-on-one.
