On ***September 27-30***, Sunday through Wednesday, we have invited ***Steve Reeves***, the dynamic pulpit minister for the 800+ member Goodman Oaks church of Christ in Southaven, Ms to present a four-day Biblical and practical series on the home. Dustin and I recently met with the elders to recommend this emphasis due to our increased efforts to reach out to young families and they gave their blessings. Dustin's Sunday morning class of 20's & 30's is growing each week and we want to further capitalize on the opportunity we have to share God's design and blueprint for marriage and the family. Our communities have hundreds of homes that are in great need of an extreme spiritual makeover. Of course, not all families need a radical overhaul. Steve's lessons on this subject will attempt to help all our homes become healthier, happier and experience greater harmony.

Here are the six topics that Steve will address: ***(1) "Your Greatest Treasure"***—our family is the anvil upon which the attitudes and convictions of life are hammered out. It is the single most influential force in your earthly life. This lesson will deal with two practical steps every family can take to insure their strength and success. ***(2) "Make or Break Attitudes"***—nothing affects your family as much as your personal attitude. An attitude of service (the mind of Christ) heals broken hearts and troubled homes. ***(3) "Your Family's Biggest Fan"***—no one wants your family to succeed more than God does. He is not against you. He loves you and wants you to do well. Here are some important things your family needs to know about God. ***(4) "Is Your Family Hurting?"***—every family experiences bumps in the road. A look at the life of Joseph and his family demonstrates the proper responses to the troubles we experience in our homes. ***(5) "When I Grow Up! Who Do You Want Your Children To Be?"***—the way in which parents raise children is one of the most powerful influences in all of life. What can parents do to form and fashion the lives of children in a Godly manner? ***(6) "What Does God Want From My Family?"***—in Deut. 10:12-13 Moses set forth five things God expected from the Israelite families. What does He expect of our families today?
