Let me encourage us that if we are the first to enter a pew to go to the middle and fill up the gaps and leave the end seats open for others who come in after us. This is important to our follow-up. Too many visitors are passing through our doors and we have no way to contact them later or send them a letter of appreciation for being a first-time visitor. We all realize the congested condition of our foyer, but you could stop on the outside and greet newcomers as the exit. The first few minutes when visitors arrive and the last as they leave are crucial in their evaluation of the congregation’s friendliness and whether they will decide to return again, so let’s give it our best efforts at meeting and greeting every visitor. And don’t forget to greet all our Christian friends who are already committed to LHD as well!

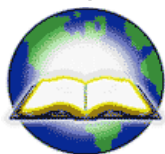
