### **SLCC—A GREAT & GOOD WORK**

You'll be pleased, I am sure, that the elders have recently made the decision to send \$1,000 to Sardis Lake Christian Camp to help provide a place to serve the spiritual growth needs of young people. Dustin recently took several of our campers to SLCC Day. This is an eventful time when campers come together from all the summer sessions and bring contributions to help support the camp. \$7,000 was collected by congregations all over the state and more will come in later. Over 1000 kids attended SLCC last summer. Many churches of Christ use the facilities for retreats during the year. Dustin & I serve on the Board of Directors. Greg Palmer has shown a great interest in joining us. Our final Board meeting of the year is Saturday, Oct 17<sup>th</sup> so, if anyone wishes to come and go with us, let me know. Dustin has served several years as a 5<sup>th</sup> Session counselor with director, Perry Jinkerson, Campus Minister of the Starkville church of Christ. Most of our kids attend this session.

### **RELIEF ASSISTANCE SENT TO SAMOA**

For several years now, we have been helping to support Rocco & Debbie Pierce in Western Samoa in the South Pacific Islands. Every month they send a detailed report and it is always encouraging. One of the ways they are able to reach the thousands of islanders is by way of radio. With the recent earthquake & tsunami hitting the coast of Samoa, which took the lives of nearly 200 people & left hundreds more homeless, Rocco & the Christians have been distributing water, food and taking care of other needs. Brother Bill Sowell, our deacon in charge of benevolence sent \$1,000 this week to the Hohenwald, TN congregation that sponsors the Pierces to aid them in their relief of the destitute families affected by this natural catastrophe. We are blessed to be a part of a giving church that cares for the physical and spiritual needs of others who are less fortunate than ourselves.

### **EVANGELISM WORKSHOP SET FOR 1/24-27/2010**

In connection with our "Setting Up a Pillar of Service" stewardship and physical expansion campaign, brother Eddie Perkins, deacon over evangelism and missions, recently suggested that soon after the first of the year, we conduct an evangelism workshop to stir us to action in personally reaching out to the lost. We have enlisted **Dan Cooper**, who preaches for the church in Pitman, NJ, and author of a Video Series on **Friendship Evangelism**. Dan conducts workshops all across the nation and we have invited him to be with us Sunday-Wednesday, Jan 24-27. I have known and followed Dan's work for years and he is highly skilled in sharing the Gospel one-on-one. The church in Pitman has grown tremendously as a result of this kind of local outreach. 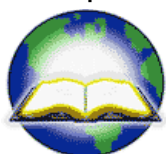
